

INVER HILLS COMMUNITY COLLEGE PARKING REGULATIONS

PAID PARKING IS AVAILABLE TO ALL INVER HILLS STUDENTS, STAFF, ADMINISTRATION AND FACULTY. ALL STUDENTS, STAFF, ADMINISTRATION AND FACULTY MUST PARK THEIR VEHICLES IN THE MAIN PARKING LOTS. THE FOLLOWING IS A SUMMARY OF THE PARKING AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS FOR INVER HILLS COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND THE PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

SECTION I- PARKING AND TRAFFIC RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED.

THE MINNESOTA STATE COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY SYSTEM, PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTE 169.966 AND MINNESOTA SESSION LAW CHAPTER 966 SECTION 20, HEREBY ADOPTS THE FOLLOWING PARKING TRAFFIC RULES AND REGULATIONS TO BE ADMINSTRATED AND ENFORCED ON THE PROPERTY OF INVER HILLS COMMUNITY COLLEGE:

1. ONLY THOSE VEHICLES BELONGING TO STUDENTS OR EMPLOYEES OF INVER HILLS OR TO OTHER PERSONS HAVING A PURPOSE OR FUNCTION AT THE COLLEGE MAY PARK ON COLLEGE PROPERTY.
2. PARKING IS PROHIBITED ON COLLEGE PROPERTY BETWEEN 12:30A.M. AND 5:30 A.M. WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTIONS:
 - A. VEHICLES THAT ARE OWNED OR LEASED BY COLLEGE OR STATE OF MINNESOTA
 - B. VEHICLES PARKED IN THE DESIGNATED 24-HOUR-A-DAY PARKING AREA LOCATED ON THE NORTHWEST END OF THE NORTH PARKING LOT.
 - C. VIOLATERS WILL BE SUBJECT TO TOWING AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COLLEGE AT THE OWNER'S EXPENSE.
3. PARKING IS PROHIBITED ON THE COLLEGE ROADWAYS, SIDEWALKS, LANDSCAPED AREAS, SAFETY ZONES, LOADING ZONES, WITHIN TEN FEET OF INTERSECTIONS, ADJACENT TO YELLOW CURBS, AND IN AREAS WHERE PARKING IS EXPRESSLY PROHIBITED BY SIGNS. EXCEPTIONS TO THIS REGULATION ARE AS FOLLOWS:
 - A. COLLEGE OWNED VEHICLES WHEN BEING USED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF WORK ON COLLEGE PROPERTY.
 - B. VEHICLES MAKING DELIVERY OF GOODS TO THE COLLEGE MAY PARK IN LOADING ZONES DURING REQUIRED DELIVERY TIME.
4. PARKING IN A RESTRICTED AREA SHALL BE LIMITED TO THOSE PERSONS WHO HAVE BEEN ISSUED A SPECIAL PERMIT FOR PARKING IN A RESTRICTED AREA. SPECIAL PERMITS ARE ISSUED BY THE PRESIDENT'S DESIGNEE IN THE FORM OF A CARD OR STICKER, WHICH MUST BE DISPLAYED WHEN THE VEHICLES PARKED IN THE RESTRICTED AREA. VIOLATERS WILL BE SUBJECT TO TOWING AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COLLEGE AT THE OWNER'S EXPENSE.
5. PARKING LANES ARE DESIGNATED BY PAINTED YELLOW LINES. ADEQUATE SPACE HAS BEEN PROVIDED BETWEEN EACH SET OF YELLOW LINES TO PARK AN AUTOMOBILE. PARKING IS RESTRICTED TO A MAXIMUM OF ONE PARKING LANE PER VEHICLE. PARKING ON THE YELLOW LANE LINES OR PARKING IN A POSITION, WHICH OCCUPIES MORE THAN ONE PARKING LANE IS PROHIBITED.
6. ALLVEHICLES ARE REQUIRED TO FOLLOW SIGNS TO GAIN ENTRANCE TO AND EXIT FROM PARKING AREAS.
7. MAXIMUM SPEED OF VEHICLES ON COLLEGE PROPERTY SHALL BE 15 MILES PER HOUR AND SUCH LESSER SPEEDS MAY BE INDICATED BY POSTED SIGNS.

8. THE DUMPING OR DEPOSITING OF ANY REFUSE ON COLLEGE PROPERTY IS PROHIBITED.
9. THE REGULATORY PROVISIONS OF MINNESOTA STATUTES 1961 CHAPTER 169, AS AMENDED, ARE HEREBY ADOPTED AS TRAFFIC REGULATION CONTROLLING THE USE OF PARKING FACILITIES AND PRIVATE ROADS, ROADWAYS AND COLLEGE PROPERTY ON PROPERTY OWNED, LEASED, OCCUPIED OR OPERATED BY INVER HILLS COMMUNITY COLLEGE.
10. NO PERSON SHALL DRIVE OR OPERATE A SNOWMOBILE, ALL TERRIAN VEHICLE, SKATEBOARD, STUNT BIKE RIDING AND OR INLINE SKATES ON PROPERTY OWNED LEASED, OCCUPIED OR OPERATED BY INVER HILLS COMMUNITY COLLEGE.
11. THE SOLICITATING AND POSTING OF ANNOUCEMENTS/ADVERTISEMENTS RELATING TO GOODS, SERVICES, ACTIVITIES, ETC... BY PLACEMENT ON OR AFFIXING TO ANY PARKED VEHICLE ON COLLEGE PROPERTY IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN.

SECTION II- ENFORCEMENT

ANY APPROPRIATE SHERIFF, CONSTABLE, POLICE OFFICER, OR OTHER PEACE OFFICER SHALL SEE THAT ALL RULES OF THIS REGULATION ARE OBEYED AND SHALL ARREST AND PROSECUTE OFFENDERS.

SECTION III PENALTIES

ANY PERSON VIOLATING PROVISION OF THESE REGULATIONS SHALL BE GUILTY OF PETTY MISDEMEANOR. ANY FINES PAID AS A RESULT OF A VIOLATION OF ANY ORDINANCE SHALL BE PAID TO THE CITY OF INVER GROVE HEIGHTS IN THE SAME MANNER AS FINES RECEIVED FROM THE VIOLATION OF CITY ORDINANCES.
