

## TRADITIONAL TRACK NURSING PROGRAM CHECK LIST

### REVIEW BEFORE APPLYING

#### **TO APPLY UNDER THE COLLEGE CRITERIA: Minimum Cumulative GPA requirement is 2.75.**

Submit nursing application with \$20 app fee (unless you previously paid an application fee to IHCC) ( )

1. Submit official copies of all previous transcripts (faxed transcripts are not accepted) It is not necessary to request an IHCC transcript. ( )
3. Take assessment inventory in English, Math, Reading. ( )

NOTATIONS: College transcripts must reflect:

Completion of a minimum of 10 college level credits. ( )

\* A cumulative GPA of 2.75 or greater. ( )

Completion of a 4 credit lab Chemistry or Biology course with a C or greater. ( )

**ASSESSMENT CLARIFICATION:** College applicants are required to take the assessment inventory in English, Reading and math. **IMPORTANT: All remedial/development coursework determined by assessments must be completed by the application deadline. Applicants must either have completed Math 90 or assessed into a higher math.**

Applicants who have current assessments on file at Inver Hills (within two years) or have completed a college level English and Math with a C or greater have met this requirement. Transfer Applicants who have earned a C or greater in a college level English composition course and a college level math course are exempt from the English and math assessment.

Students with a previous Bachelor's Degree from an English speaking country are exempt from the Reading Comprehension, and Writing English assessment. If previous transcripts reflect a college level math course (Inver Hills Math 1101/Century Math 1025 or higher) with a minimum grade of C these applicants are also exempt from the math assessment.

International applicants are required to take the English, Math & Reading assessment.. Foreign transcripts must be evaluated by World Education Service (W.E.S.) [info@wes.org](mailto:info@wes.org) or (212) 966-6311.

#### **TO APPLY UNDER THE HIGH SCHOOL CRITERIA:**

(Only high school graduates from 2009, 2010) High school graduates from prior years must meet requirements under the college criteria.

1. Submit nursing application with \$20 app fee (unless you previously paid an application fee to IHCC) ( )
2. Submit official H.S. transcript (Transcript must reflect high school rank of 50% or greater, completion of Biology and Chemistry with C or greater. ( )
3. Submit evidence of standardized assessment\* ( )
4. Take assessment inventory in English, Math, Reading ( )  
Assessments must not reflect any required mandatory preparatory or remedial coursework

NOTATIONS: GED recipients may not apply under this category, but must qualify under the college criteria.

Standardized assessment\*ACT COMP 21 or greater, PSAT Verbal 42 or greater,  
Verbal & Math 89 or greater, or SAT verbal/math combined of 900 or greater.
