What is the Alliss Opportunity Grant?

The Alliss Opportunity Grant is a program to help adults try a course at Inver Hills. The grant provides payment of tuition and required textbook(s) for one course (up to five credits) per academic year on a funds-available basis. Grant money is provided by the Alliss Education Foundation and is not based on family income.

Bring the completed application with you when you register. You must be able to answer yes to the certification questions below to be eligible (and funds must still be available); additional requirements may apply. After you register for your course, a voucher will be given to the College Bookstore to purchase required book(s) for your Alliss Grant course.
