About scholarships at Inver Hills

The Inver Hills Community College Foundation provides numerous scholarship opportunities for both new and current students. Current scholarships are described briefly here. The actual number of scholarships and award amounts vary each year depending on donor participation. You may visit the foundation website for the most current list of scholarships, complete descriptions, frequently asked questions, and tips for preparing your application: www.inverhills.edu/Foundation.

Scholarship requirements vary by program and may include academic achievement (merit), financial need, leadership, community involvement, academic or career goals, family status, community of residence, and other factors. You will be considered for all scholarships for which you are eligible based on the information you provide on the application form. Notification of awards usually occurs four to six weeks after application deadlines each term.

- Applications are evaluated based on six criteria: scholastic achievement; career goals; financial need; recommendations/honors; campus or community service/leadership; and life circumstances (plus any “special consideration” requirements listed with the scholarship).
- Applications are reviewed and awards determined by the scholarship committee according to policies and requirements set by the college, the foundation, and scholarship sponsors.
- “New students” are those who have never attended Inver Hills before, including students now in high school. “Current students” are those who are enrolled at Inver Hills now or attended previously.
- Students may be disqualified for scholarship consideration for not adhering to the college’s code of conduct requirements and policies related to student behavior.
- Scholarship awards usually are made as a credit to the student’s tuition/fees account.
- Scholarship award amounts for full-year scholarships are split equally between fall and spring term; spring term attendance is required or the balance of the scholarship is forfeited.
- Recipients may receive only one Inver Hills scholarship a term.
- Scholarship funds must be returned if a student does not complete the term.

Fall or spring; evidence of clear academic goals; special consideration for financial need, life circumstances; demonstrated academic achievement; \$500

Book Store Scholarship

Fall or spring; demonstrated academic achievement and evidence of well-formulated academic and career goals; special consideration for financial need, life circumstances; \$500.

Bruce Dayton Scholarship

Fall and spring; student enrolled in Chinese Studies Program; demonstrated academic achievement and well-formulated academic and career goals; special consideration for financial need and life circumstances; \$500

Building Brighter Futures Scholarship

Fall and spring; evidence of clear career goals; special consideration for financial need; special consideration for challenging life circumstances; demonstrated academic achievement; \$500

Carl Richards Memorial Scholarship

Fall; full time; pursuing a degree in physical education, campus recreation, or teaching; cumulative g.p.a. of 2.00 or higher; \$500

Dakota Electric Scholarship

Fall and spring; part time; evidence of well-formulated academic and career goals; special consideration for financial need; special consideration for limited family financial support; special consideration for extraordinary life challenges; cumulative g.p.a. of 2.00 or higher; up to \$600 (tuition only)

Don Tompkins Memorial Scholarship

Fall; evidence of clear academic goals; special consideration given for financial need; evidence of volunteer or leadership activities; \$1,000

Doug Knapp Memorial Scholarship

Fall or spring; evidence of academic achievement, leadership and volunteerism; consideration for financial need and life circumstances. Amount varies.

Eagan Rotary Scholarship

Fall or spring; awarded to resident of Eagan; demonstrated academic achievement and well-formulated academic and career goals; special consideration for financial need; amount varies

Elaine Lucking Memorial Scholarship

Fall and spring; demonstrated interest in business with a marketing or sales emphasis and evidence of well-formulated academic and career goals; special consideration for financial need; cumulative grade-point average of 2.00 or higher; \$500

Ellen McGee Scholarship

Full or part time; evidence of clear career goals; demonstrated campus or community service or leadership; special consideration for financial need; special consideration for challenging life circumstances; amount varies.

Eva Morgan Scholarship

Fall and spring; must live south of College Trail (southern boundary of the Inver Hills campus); special consideration for financial need; cumulative g.p.a. of 3.00 or higher; \$500

Flint Hills STEM Scholarship

Fall and spring; full or part time; science, technology, engineering and math students. (Does not include health care practitioner.) Cumulative g.p.a. of 3.0 or higher; \$1250 to \$2500

Forrest Glewwe Golf Tournament Scholarship

Fall and spring; evidence of clear career goals; special consideration for financial need; special consideration for challenging life circumstances; demonstrated academic achievement; \$500 to \$1,000

Frank Mitchell Memorial Scholarship

Fall only; pursuing a degree in business; evidence of well-formulated career goals in business, sales, or marketing; \$250

GED Scholarship

Fall semester; student must submit GED examinee form with test scores; evidence of academic achievement, leadership and volunteerism; consideration for financial need and life circumstances. \$500

George A. Slipka Accounting Scholarship

Full-year (fall-spring) for two years; full or part time; pursuing a two-year or four-year accounting degree; evidence of clear career goals; special consideration for financial need; evidence of community service, leadership, or previous work experience; minimum of part-time employment while enrolled; maintain 3.00 g.p.a. and progress toward an accounting degree for renewal the following term; full scholarship up to \$5,000 annually (awarded by semester for tuition and books only)

Key Community Bank Scholarship

Fall and spring; evidence of clear career goals; special consideration for financial need; evidence of leadership and volunteerism; demonstrated academic achievement; \$500

Kopp Investment Advisors Presidential Scholarship

Fall and spring; full or part time; evidence of well-formulated academic and career goals; special consideration for financial need; special consideration for extraordinary life challenges; cumulative g.p.a. of 2.00 or higher; \$500 to \$1,000 (tuition only)

LeRoy Nelson Nursing Scholarship

Fall or spring; student must have been admitted into the nursing program; demonstrated academic achievement; consideration for financial need and life circumstances; special consideration for first generation college student; \$500

Phuong Nguyen Memorial Scholarship

Fall or spring; student must be enrolled in accounting or business program; evidence of academic achievement, leadership and volunteerism; consideration for financial need and life circumstances. \$1000-\$500

Robert and Alexandra Klas Endowed Scholarship

Fall and spring; evidence of clear academic and career goals; special consideration for financial need; demonstrated academic achievement. Award amount varies.

Ruth Gessner Memorial Scholarship

Fall or spring; student must be enrolled in coursework in developmental reading or writing and show satisfactory progress. One of the letters of recommendation must come from the instructor of the reading or writing class. Consideration for campus or community service, financial need and extraordinary life circumstances. Amount varies.

Additional Scholarship Opportunities

- High school students should check with their counseling office for information about scholarship opportunities, especially those funded through local organizations and businesses.
- Many adult students who have not been in high school or college for at least 7 years and who do not have a bachelor's degree qualify for an Alliss Opportunity Grant. Additional restrictions apply. Covers tuition for one class up to 5 credits plus book allowance. Call 651/450-3518 to request Alliss Grant forms.
- Current/former Inver Hills students should stop by the Counseling Office in the College Center for information about scholarships.

SKB Environmental Rosemount Community Trust Scholarship

Fall and spring; 5 credits minimum; special consideration for financial need; must be Rosemount resident; up to \$1,000 full time, \$500 part time (tuition only)

Student Scholarship+ Program Scholarship

Full-year (fall-spring); full or part time both terms; at least half of credits must be in degree courses (numbered 1000 or higher); special consideration for financial need; cumulative g.p.a. of 3.00 or higher to qualify and for spring semester renewal; \$1,000 to \$2,000 (one-half awarded per semester)

Terri Kroshus Memorial Scholarship

Fall or spring; student must be enrolled in accounting or business program; evidence of academic achievement, leadership and volunteerism; consideration for financial need and life circumstances. \$1000-\$500

Veterans Scholarship

Fall or spring; full or part time; available for veterans or persons currently serving in the military; evidence of clear career goals; special consideration for financial need; special consideration for challenging life circumstances; cumulative g.p.a. of 2.00 or higher; amount varies.

Thomson Reuters STEM Scholarship

Fall and spring; full or part time; science, technology, engineering and math students. (Does not include health care practitioner.) Demonstrated academic achievement; \$1000-\$2000

Veterans Club-Carol Juers Memorial Scholarship

Fall or spring; full or part time; for veteran, spouse of veteran or child of veteran; evidence of clear career goals, financial need, challenging life circumstances, academic achievement, leadership and volunteerism. Applicant must describe in the "life circumstances" portion of the essay if they are a veteran, married to veteran, or a child of a veteran to be eligible to receive this scholarship; \$250

Debi Malicki Memorial Scholarship

Fall or spring; at least two semesters of mathematics at IHCC; registered for at least 6 credits; must have taken at least one developmental MATH class (numbered below 1000) and has demonstrated success in at least one college level math course; minimum of 12 IHCC credits completed; cumulative grade-point average of 3.20 or higher; \$500 to \$1,000

Dennis Anderson Memorial Scholarship

Fall and spring; Phi Theta Kappa member in good standing; special consideration for financial need; \$500 to \$1,000 (tuition or books)

Nursing Scholarship

Fall or spring (awarded only once per year); third- or fourth-semester nursing student; special consideration for financial need; special consideration for single parent; cumulative g.p.a. of 3.00 or higher; \$1,000

President's Emerging Leader Scholarship

Full-year (fall-spring); full time; evidence of exemplary leadership experience and qualities and future leadership goals; evidence of clear career goals; letter of nomination from IHCC faculty/adviser/administrator; \$1000 (one-half awarded per semester)

- Current Inver Hills students must attach an "unofficial" transcript (students may print unofficial transcripts from their Inver Hills student record; please print transcript, not degree audit report.)
- New students must attach an official copy of their most recent transcript (either high school or college or GED scores). Start early to ensure you receive transcripts in time to meet the appropriate deadline.
- New students transferring from other colleges must submit official transcripts from **all** previous colleges with this application form.
- Respond to the five questions listed in Section II of this application form by preparing a written narrative. Your application will not be considered without this narrative.
- Two signed recommendation letters should be included with your application. If possible, one letter should be from an instructor. (Do not submit more than two letters of recommendation.)
- All scholarship applicants must apply for federal financial aid using the FAFSA (www.fafsa.ed.gov) regardless of whether you qualify for aid or not. This form must be filled out yearly. If you are unable to fill out this form for any reason, please call 651/450-3714. All information will be kept confidential.
- Send or bring all appropriate materials to the Inver Hills Community College Foundation, Liberal Arts Building, 2500 East 80th Street, Inver Grove Heights, MN 55076. Applications are not considered until they are complete.
