

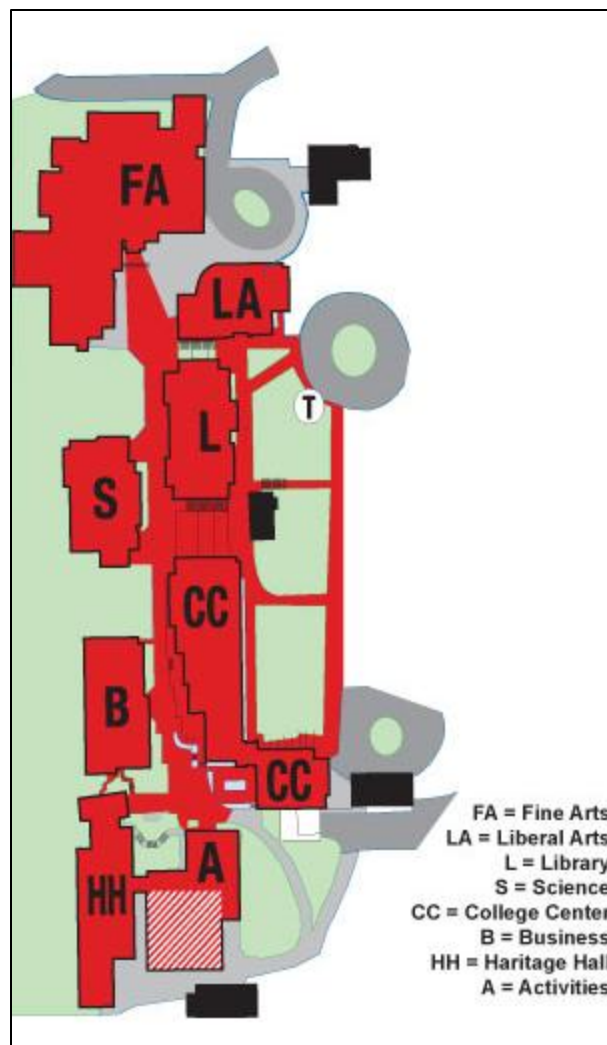
Connecting to the Wireless Network

What is SafeConnect?

SafeConnect is a bring-your-own-device (BYOD) network access control technology the college uses to provide wireless network services that comply with Minnesota State Colleges and Universities Board of Trustee policy. Board of Trustee policy currently has two primary requirements:

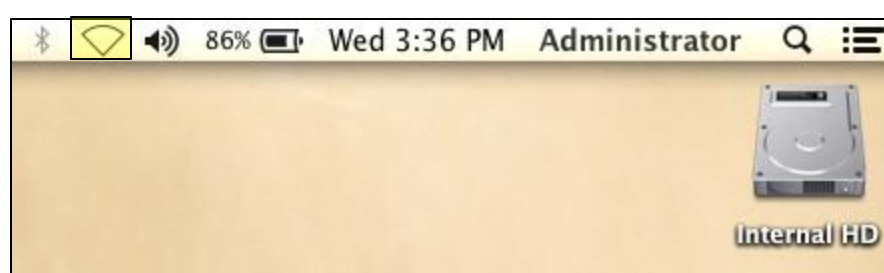
- Specific network behavior must be attributable to an individual
- Devices on the network must be configured to prevent abuse

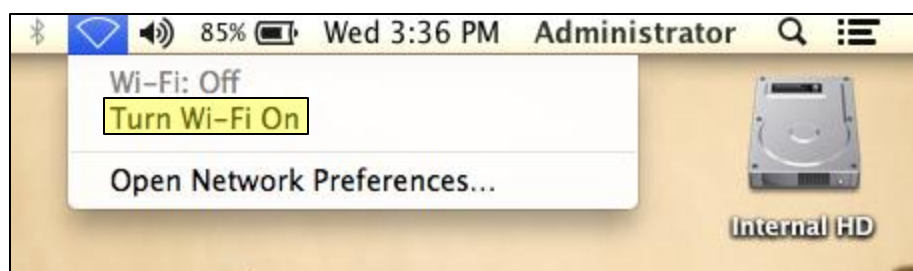


This map shows what parts of campus are covered by our wireless network

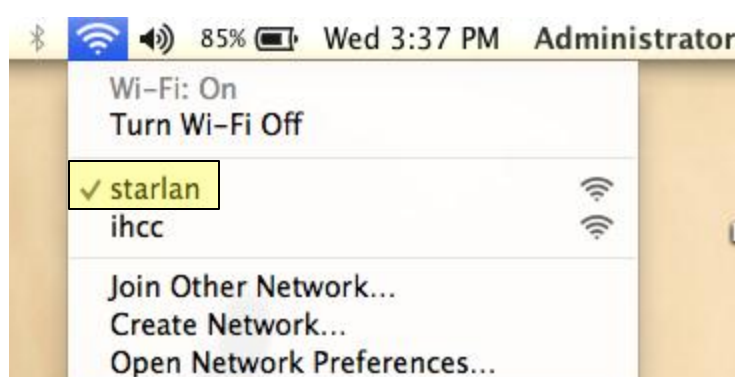
Connecting to the Wireless Network (Mac)



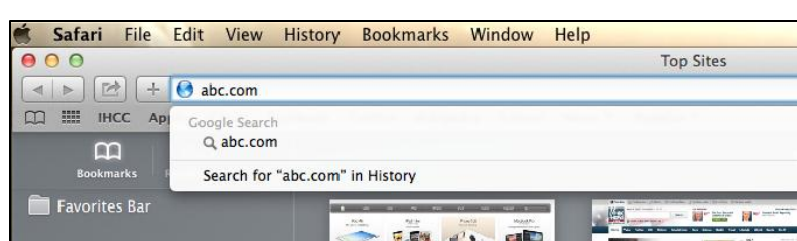
Begin by verifying that your wireless is turned on.



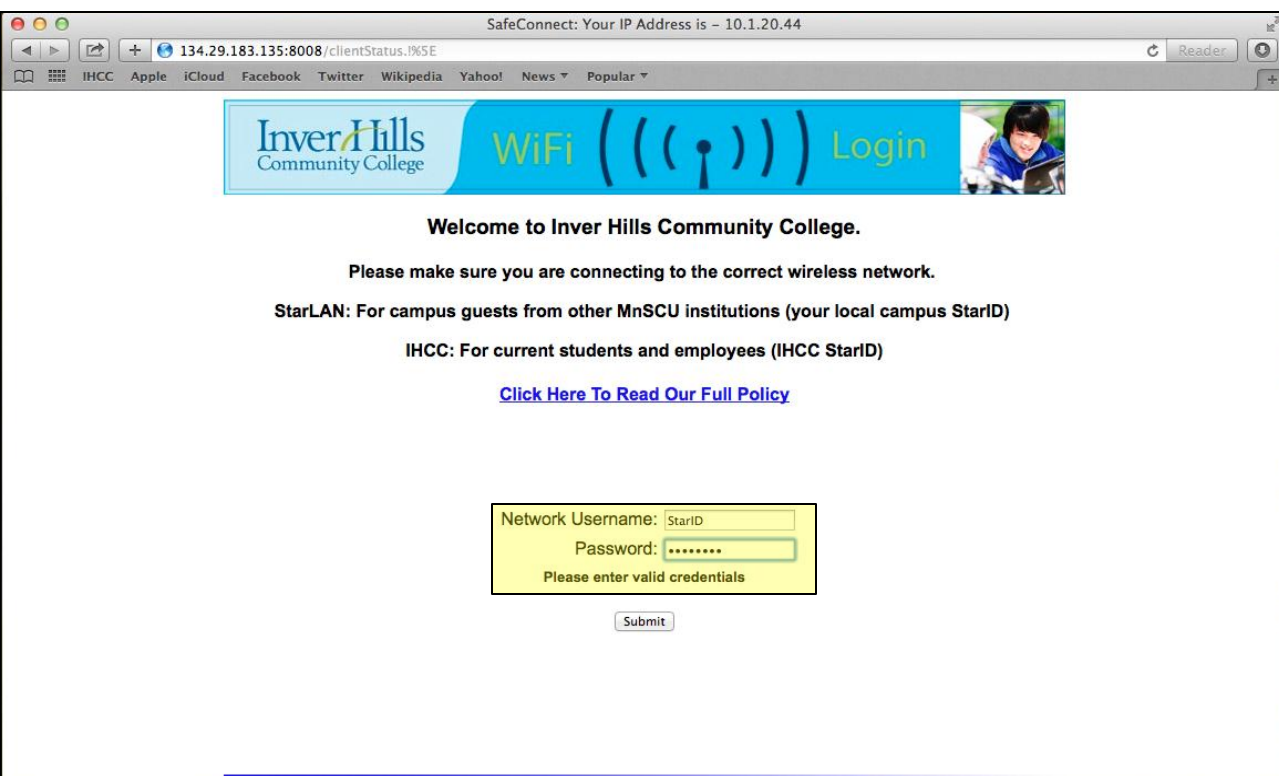
With your wireless turned on, Click on the highlighted icon in the system tray, and join the "StarLan" wireless network by clicking on it.



Navigate to a website, such as abc.com



You will be challenged to authenticate by SafeConnect. Enter in your StarID and Password.



You will then be directed to the Inver Hills webpage. You are now on the wireless network.
