

Criteria for CBL community partners:

- Nonprofit/not for profit
- Their opportunity must align with the learning objectives and commitment option (i.e. number of hours) that faculty have for class
 - Based on current CBL courses, this means accommodating a 15-hour minimum assignment in a semester for non-nursing and education courses
- Onboarding/training prior to beginning service must not be more than 5 hours
- Signed MOU which includes ADA compliance and non-discrimination practices
- Partner agrees to sign student time logs

Students may propose a community partner that is not on our current list of partners. New community partners must be approved by the Center for Career Development in order to satisfy CBL requirements.
