Students must meet the course prerequisite requirements established by the college.

PSEO students are not permitted to take developmental courses not considered college level (numbered below 1000).

PSEO students are not permitted to audit a course or take a course on a pass/fail basis.

PSEO students are not permitted to take non-credit courses.

PSEO students are not permitted to take courses that incur travel expenses.

The costs of certain items are not covered by the program such as computer software programs and equipment or supplies that become the property of the student. The program does not cover general school supplies.

Note: **ART 1121, ART 1131, and ART 1132, Digital Photography** courses, require that students provide their own digital camera. The cost of the digital camera and required image editing software are not covered by the PSEO funding. The image editing software is available for use in the computer lab at Inver Hills.

Note: **BIOL 1120, Exploring Biology**, requires the use of a microscope. When this course is taken fully online, the cost of a microscope is not covered by the PSEO funding. Students must have access to their own microscope or may use a microscope in the science labs at Inver Hills with the permission of an instructor.
