

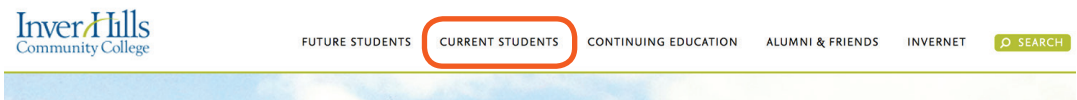
YOUR DEGREE AUDIT REPORTING SYSTEM (DARS) REPORT

Find out how your coursework applies toward your degree and which courses you still need to take to graduate. Your DARS report is a tool for you to monitor your progress toward the degree you have declared. The report can help you:

- > **PLAN** which courses you need to register for to earn your degree.
- > **VIEW** how your transfer coursework from another college or university, the military or other source applies toward your degree.
- > **CONFIRM** that the courses you register for meet your degree requirements.

FOLLOW THE STEPS BELOW TO VIEW YOUR DARS REPORT

1. From the Inver Hills website home page, select the **CURRENT STUDENTS** tab.



2. Select the **E-SERVICES** tab. Login with your StarID and password.

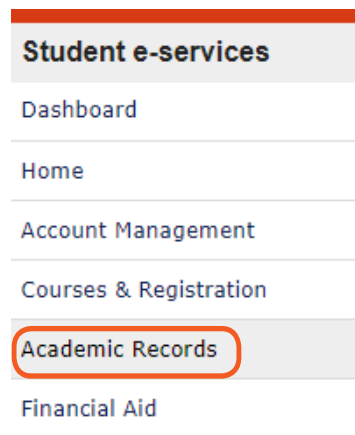
