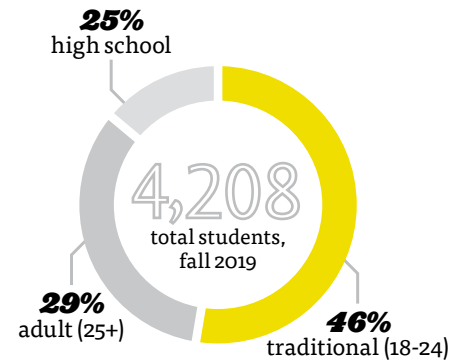

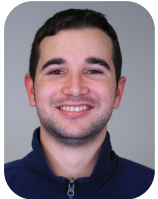

Enrollment Checklist

Apply to Inver Hills

Applications are due prior to each semester's application deadline, usually no later than the week before the term. A one-time, non-refundable **\$20 application fee is usually required**. Applications are available online at inverhills.edu/apply and a paper application is available by request. The application fee can be paid in person in the Enrollment Center or online at inverhills.edu. The application fee may be waived if you are a veteran or qualify for a [NACAC fee waiver](#). Completing your online application typically takes less than 20 minutes.

Apply for Financial Aid

(NOT REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION, STRONGLY RECOMMENDED)

Apply for financial aid today at www.fafsa.ed.gov and get free, earned or borrowed money. Find more information at inverhills.edu/FinancialAid or call our Financial Aid Office with any questions at **651-450-3495**. Inver Hills' FAFSA school code is 006935. You can also explore, email, or call for more information about [Inver's Foundation](#) (which grants scholarships to students) and [general payment plan options](#) (including third party payers; payment plans; and more).

Submit Transcripts

If possible, submit official college transcripts from all previous, non-Minnesota State colleges and universities you have attended, including PSEO and any other courses that may have been awarded college credit. Also, unofficial high school transcripts are helpful for assessment placement purposes and sometimes for financial aid purposes and should be submitted as well. Fulfill Assessment Test Requirements

This requirement can be met in multiple ways: exemptions to testing can be made for qualifying college credit, standardized test scores (ACT, SAT, MCAs, etc), or a combination of high school GPA and standardized test scores.
